Message

Rockaway Valley Soccer League is now members of the New Jersey Youth Soccer. This change requires all towns who enter teams into the league to also become members of the NJYS as well. Amongst the recreation program benefits of membership includes education opportunities, playing opportunities, communications, awards programs as well as protection of players/coaches.

Included with the membership is also liability and medical insurance to registered players, volunteer registered coaches, volunteer referees, administrators, volunteers. Coverage information is listed on the NJYS website.

If you would like to volunteer to coach your name and full address is required for us to share with NJYA for insurance coverage.

In addition to digital fingerprints & Rutgers Training required by the town, adult volunteers will also be required to be registered through the KidSafe Program. The KidSafe Disclosure Form is required for us to have on file and possibly share information with NJYS for additional background checks if necessary.

Please be sure to complete both the MTA Volunteer Coach form and the NJYSA Kidsafe Disclosure Form, ***you will not be able to coach without both forms completed***. You can fill out both forms at the time of registration, or you may find the forms on our website, www.mtasoccer.com on the coach's page and drop it off to the finance department at Borough Hall.
